Job Summary:

We are seeking a skilled and experienced Obstetrician/ Gynecologist to provide comprehensive care for women's reproductive health, including antenatal care, childbirth, and postpartum care, in a rural hospital in a beautiful part of West Bengal India. The ideal candidate will be knowledgeable in obstetrics and gynecology procedures, experienced in managing high-risk pregnancies, and willing to encourage oversee staff nurses and midwives to encourage low risk births.

Responsibilities:

- Conducting routine antenatal examinations and providing counselling on lifestyle and nutrition during pregnancy
- Monitoring fetal development through ultrasounds and other diagnostic tests
- Managing labour and birth, and postpartum care, including performing or overseeing cesarean sections or other necessary interventions
- Diagnosing and treating gynaecological conditions such as endometriosis, fibroids, ovarian cysts, etc.
- Performing surgical procedures such as hysterectomies, laparoscopies or hysteroscopies when needed
- Collaborating with other healthcare professionals to ensure comprehensive care for patients, including with the two part time senior doctors
- Overseeing the two junior (MBBS doctors) and developing their skills
- In additional Medical Superintendency or Chief Medical Officer roles are available

- Medical degree from an accredited school of medicine
- Board certification in obstetrics/gynecology (OB/GYN)
- Valid medical license to practice obstetrics/gynecology
- Solid experience in managing normal & complicated pregnancies
- Strong surgical skills with experience in both vaginal deliveries & cesarean sections
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong commitment to patient care and safety
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Willingness to stay updated with the latest developments in obstetrics and gynecology
- Compassion, empathy, and sensitivity towards the needs of pregnant women and their families
- Willingness to be committed to live in a rural area

Situation

Kristiya Seva Niketan (KSN) is a Christian Mission Hospital built in 1914, situated in the village of Sarenga, in the District of Bankura. It is 60 km away from Bankura town, and 104 km away from the Coal and Steel mining town of Durgapur. In 2014, Sarenga CD block had 1 rural hospital and 1 primary health centre with a total of 202 beds and 6 doctors. It had 17 family welfare sub centres and 1 family welfare centre. Sarenga Rural Hospital, with 30 beds, in Krishnapur, is a government medical facility in the Sarenga CD block, 13 km from Sarenga.

The hospital is a 100 bedded hospital, currently with about 30-50 patients. It has had a great reputation for kind caring service and skilled nurses who passed out from the on site Nurse Training school which was built in 1962. Currently there are 75 students in various stages of their GNM training, 3 years of 25 students per year, with the Christian students having to work a bond year as staff nurses once they have qualified.

There are many hospital buildings including a maternity ward, neonatal unit, antenatal and postnatal ward, paediatric ward, male and female wards, Outpatients departments, ophthalmology department, X ray, pharmacy and laboratory testing, a functioning OT and a blood bank about to be commissioned. There is accommodation for the nursing students, doctors and other staff within the compound, as well as guest bungalows. The grounds are teeming with plants and bird life, and the ambience is peaceful and calming. There is a chapel in the grounds, with daily morning prayers and ward prayers on Wednesdays. There are close links with the Church in the village and the girls' hostel, Marsal Duar, within the hospital grounds.

Remuneration

Accommodation is available within the hospital grounds, in a beautiful, well-built and maintained, bungalow, with recent refurbishments to the bathrooms and kitchen.

A respectable salary can be provided, and terms and conditions can be negotiated.

This is a full-time position that will require on-call duties, with the opportunity to develop and practice your skills to the benefit of a wide range of rural, disadvantaged people.
