## **New Partnership Coordinator for Africa**

The Revd Dr. Andrew Ashdown has been appointed Partnership Coordinator for Africa for the Methodist Church in Britain. He is a Church of England priest, ordained for 30 years, and has served as Incumbent in 4 parishes in Britain.



Most recently he has been working as Manager of Advocacy and Good Governance for the International charity, Humanitarian Aid Relief Trust (HART) UK, which has included high level advocacy work on Nigeria, Sudan and South Sudan. He has also worked as Regional Officer for South Asia for the Anglican Mission Agency, USPG.

Andrew spent his childhood and formative years in Zimbabwe as a child of missionary parents. During the last 30 years of ministry, he has been Chair of Diocesan and Deanery links with Uganda, Burundi, Ghana, and Tanzania; and has developed partnership strategies, and organised and led numerous link visits to partners. Andrew's Doctoral research on Christian-Muslim relations in Syria, was published by Routledge in 2019. The importance of this field for Africa was recognised at a Church of Kenya Conference in Mombasa in 2019, at which he spoke on how the Church in Africa might address the rise of religious extremism in the African context. Andrew very much looks forward to getting to know our Partner Churches and Organisations, and Mission Partners in the region.






## Looking and listening for God in Scripture, and the world
